



Bath Rugby Residential Camps FAQs

1. What is the Bath Rugby Residential?

Bath Rugby will be hosting two residential rugby camps this summer:

Bournemouth Collegiate School: 5 -10 August

Warminster School: 19 -24 August

The camp will be for junior boy rugby players U13 to U16s and is designed to give an insight into what a week of a professional rugby player is like.

2. What content will be covered?

The majority of sessions will be dedicated to rugby to help develop individual and team skills, as well as demonstrating good cognitive skills, resilience and creative thinking. Sessions will include nutrition and education workshops, analysis and reflection sessions, strength and conditioning and recovery sessions.

3. How long are the days?

The day will start at 9am and run until 6pm, with an hour for lunch and scheduled breaks throughout the day. Evening group activities will commence from 7.30pm.

4. What will be the sleeping arrangements?

Participants will be split between rooms of 6 beds, 3 beds, twins and singles. Children, where possible, will be paired with participants of a similar age.

5. What are the food options?

Our menu has been carefully planned to mirror that of a menu at Bath Rugby's training ground. Meals will cater for most tastes and we can accommodate any food allergies (that are highlighted well in advance of the camp dates).

6. Can parents attend to watch during the week?

Unfortunately not, but they will be invited on the last day for lunch and to watch the camp awards.

7. What kit do they need to bring and will it be washed?

There will be no washing facilities so we recommend plenty of kit. A full kit list will be sent out before the camp.

8. Is there free down time? And is this supervised?

Yes there is some down time, these will be supervised activities such as camp quiz, movie nights etc.

9. Adult/coach supervision for residential participants

All coaches will be DBS cleared RFU qualified Bath Rugby Community coaches and will be first aid trained. Coaches will be based in the same facility and building as participants and will be supervised at all times.

10. Phones/valuables

Your child can bring a phone to camp if they wish but we ask that they do not bring them into the sessions as they can often prove distracting. If they would like to bring a laptop, handheld games console etc. this is acceptable but it is their own responsibility to ensure it's looked after. Bath Rugby are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal items of a participants, and are not responsible to replace them in any way.

11. Weather

In the event that inclement weather prohibits the players to train outside, an alternative indoor facility will be made available or will be brought to a safe indoor or covered area until the weather has passed.

Bath Rugby will do its best under these circumstances to proceed with the activities, but the participant's safety is our first priority. If a training session is missed during to severe weather and is unable to be taken indoors, we will do our best to make up that session during the remainder of the camp. Bath Rugby is unable to issue any type of refund for severe weather prior to, during or after the camp.

13. Parents/Guardian

14. Transport

Unfortunately we cannot assist in collections or drop offs at airports, train stations or bus stations. All participants must be dropped off and collected by a registered guardian.

15. Refunds

Any cancellations made on or before the 31st May 2018 in writing to Bath Rugby are entitled to a 100% refund; any made on or before the 2nd July 2018 will be entitled to a 50% refund. Any cancellations (including injuries) made on or after the 2nd July 2018 will not be entitled to a refund.
